ATR VERDICT: MOUNT ARARAT failed to land a gamble when third at Beverley two weeks ago, but he sets a fair form standard after finishing fourth in a French Listed race last summer and has been located a great opening here by Karl Burke. Jonathan Fisher's 7lb claim can give the four-year-old a helping hand and the pair can prove too strong for Mutarakez, who has only won one of his last 30 starts but that was this race 12 months ago, and Kripke, who shaped well at Redcar last month following a 338-day absence.

ATR VERDICT: ZERO TEN lost his unbeaten hurdles record when denied by less than a length in a Grade 2 at Fairyhouse and, on that showing, looks more than capable of successfully giving weight all round. The Big Dog was disappointing when fancied for a Grade 1 at the Dublin Racing Festival, but had got the better of Voix Des Tiep at Gowran the time before and could confirm that form despite the latter winning since. Whatsafellatodo won two on the bounce in the autumn and could take another step forward having joined Martin Brassil.
