ATR VERDICT: THOMAS MACDONAGH was left alone after 13 fences in a three-runner race at Catterick last month and did what was required to score in the final stages. A recent wind operation may have sparked some improvement, and the eight-year-old might be fairly treated back in handicaps off 132 after that confidence-booster 44 days ago. Lithic keeps running well in defeat but is 0-22 over fences, while Highland Hunter was probably beaten when falling at Chepstow last time but deserves respect on his earlier third in a competitive Grade 3 handicap over hurdles at Haydock.

ATR VERDICT: Schiehallion Munro won over 2m3f when last visiting this track but he's 9lb higher here and up significantly in trip, while stablemate Justforjames was behind Lough Derg Jewel over this C&D last time and a 6lb swing in his favour might not be enough for him to get his revenge. Didero Vallis is 2lb lower than when second in the Rowland Meyrick at Wetherby in 2019, but recent efforts have left a lot to be desired, so WHO'S IN THE BOX gets the vote. Nick Kent's runner was a gutsy winner at Market Rasen last time and the second has since franked the form. Carrying a feather weight in testing conditions will aid his cause here.
