ATR VERDICT: An unfortunate incident denied SHOAL BAY a fourth win over fences at Worcester last month, with the saddle slipping and he unseated his rider with the race at his mercy. ATR VERDICT: INDIANA ROSE might be able to provide Jack Kearney with his first racecourse success in this very competitive contest. From Navan, the teenager gave Effernock Fizz a very polished ride to finish second at Bellewstown last week. He now teams up with Indiana Rose for Pat Martin, with this daughter of Elzaam a winner at Naas in August. She has failed to follow up in three starts since but will be helped here by Kearney's claim. Ceapach Rua is given second preference with Daniel King, who is another very promising apprentice, in the saddle. The Co Cork native made the breakthrough aboard Malbas at Killarney on Saturday and followed up on his very next ride, scoring aboard Plum Perfect at Tipperary on Tuesday. Both of those wins were for Denis Hogan, with Ceapach Rua also trained by the Tipperary maestro. Coffeemeanscoffee beat Ceapach Rua at Cork and the Tom McGuinness-trained six-year-old reopposes. The dual winner is likely to have plenty of supporters, while others for the shortlist are Cork runner-up Tullypole Annie, C&D winner Harry's Hill and top-weight Showmolina.

ATR VERDICT: INFLECTION POINT might be able to defy top-weight and win this for the second year in a row. The Kieran Cotter-trained five-year-old is a talented sort and recorded a third career win at Fairyhouse in July. He had no luck when last of nine on his most recent start at Down Royal and that effort can be discounted. Tide Of Time is a four-time C&D winner and the Eddie Lynam-trained seven-year-old is given second preference. The son of Choisir registered a seventh career success at Bellewstown last week, and it'll come as no surprise if he manages to follow up. Anjalawi returns to action after nearly a year off. She made the breakthrough on her most recent start at Dundalk in October of last year, and it'll be interesting to see how she fares. Texas Rock beat Dragons Call by a head when they clashed at the Curragh in August. Dragons Call since won at Cork and both are likely to have plenty of supporters. Zephron and Sounds Of Spring are others who warrant respect.
