ATR VERDICT: Dermot Weld has a strong hand in this with Azallya, who got off the mark at the fourth attempt when beating an 89-rated rival at Cork. A mark of 92 looks fair for her handicap bow, while Jake Coen's 10lb claim will give Dalton Highway a chance after he was raised 4lb following a Killarney win. The latter also won a handicap over this track and trip, but DEWCUP was only a head behind him that day and Ted Walsh's charge is 6lb better off in this, so could be the answer. This may be a tough race to break your maiden tag, but he has been in fine form on the level without winning. Turnpike Trip, Dunvegan, Celestial Horizon and National Ballet are others to note.

ATR VERDICT: JANUARY JETS has been off since April but has a good record fresh and can gain his second win over fences. Having been runner-up to Envoi Allen on chasing debut, he won well at Leopardstown over Christmas before finding Grade One company beyond him at Fairyhouse. This looks a more realistic target and he can get the better of likely market rival Karl De Grosse. The latter came good on his third chase start when beating subsequent winner Busselton over further at Killarney. With his confidence boosted by that success, he looks a big danger.
