ATR VERDICT: In a wide-open renewal of this contest a chance can be taken on BRANDO, who has a decent record in this race and he may well be underestimated in the market. The veteran was only beaten a nose by Glen Shiel at 80/1 12 months ago and he proved that he retained his ability when filling fourth place in the Prix Maurice de Gheest in August. Kevin Ryan's gelding had the likes of Kinross, Rohaan and Glen Shiel behind him on that that occasion, while his effort in the July Cup was also very promising. His most recent effort can be forgiven as he is not a 5f performer and that was likely to be just a prep run for this. Dragon Symbol is a consistent colt who should be in the mix once again, while the unexposed Minzaal caught the eye on his return to action here two weeks ago. The shortlist is completed by Art Power and Happy Romance.

ATR VERDICT: Hard to confidently rule anything in or out of this, but JUST GOT TO GET ON looks potentially well treated for his chasing bow. Oliver Greenall's gelding went well here in a bumper on his debut and had shown enough over hurdles to be sent off favourite for his most recent start at Carlisle, only to lose his action on the downhill turn when still travelling sweetly at the head of affairs. Numbers Man and Valentine's Turf both return after wind operations and would be of interest if the market vibes are positive, while winning pointer File Illico also merits respect on his chasing bow despite being uninspiring over hurdles.

ATR VERDICT: Snowfall merits the utmost respect given how impressively she won the Oaks, Irish Oaks and Yorkshire Oaks earlier in the season, but she arrives here after a tough run in the Arc just two weeks ago and it may be best to take her on at the likely prices. With that in mind, preference is for ESHAADA, who remains unexposed and her career best came over this C&D when finishing second in the Ribblesdale in June. The daughter of Muhaarar disappointed in the Yorkshire Oaks last time but that run was too bad to be true and she can be given another chance. Albaflora is a likeable filly who is more than capable of making the frame, while Lady Hayes should appreciate this step back up in trip.



ATR VERDICT: The penny is really starting to drop with MANINTHESHADOWS on the evidence of a smooth win over a similar trip at Worcester last month and a follow-up wouldn't appear beyond him. Jonjo O'Neill's six-year-old has taken time to come to hand but he hurdled much cleaner than previously last time and a 5lb rise may not be enough to anchor him in this sort of grade. Racing Spirit and Calarules ran well to fill the places in the same race at Worcester latest, but the less exposed Malinas Island looks a bigger threat having shown signs of improvement over a longer trip last time.

ATR VERDICT: A race consisting of some of the best milers in Europe, with slight preference for the proven quantity that is PALACE PIER. The only defeat of his career came in this race last year when losing a shoe, but conditions should be much more suitable today for the five-time Group 1 winner. The potential fly in the ointment could be Baaeed, who is a rising star and is unbeaten in five starts, including when a comfortable winner of the Prix Du Moulin. This is the acid test for William Haggas' charge as he has never taken on quality such as this before, but the 3lb he receives from the selection could help. Last year's winner The Revenant may not have his ideal conditions, while 2000 Guineas second Master Of The Seas is another to note.
