The Brian Meehan-trained gelding can handle the step up in grade and post his third successive win, possibly at the expense of **New Mission**, who looks the type to progress as he gains more experience. **Oh Herberts Reign** had something in hand when scoring at Doncaster on his latest start and also makes the shortlist.

ATR VERDICT: COPPER COIN is a gelding on the up, building on chase/novice hurdle victories earlier this year when bolting up on his handicap debut in this sphere at Uttoxeter almost a month ago. A 9lb rise for that effort is fair and this progressive son of Sulamani is fancied to strike again. The main danger could be Morraman, who brings winning C&D form to the table and was touched off at Hereford most recently. Pammi is also a winner here and warrants respect off bottom-weight.

ATR VERDICT: NOBLE DYNASTY didn't get a clear run when fifth at Haydock on his latest start, but the application of cheekpieces for the first time is likely to see the son of Dubawi take a step back in the right direction. Greatgadian won over an extended mile at Nottingham on his penultimate start and he is capable of bouncing back from a below-par effort at Epsom, while State Occasion and Ropey Guest appear best of the remainder.
